Co-op Program Participation Fee

All Co-op students (Canadian and International, undergraduate and graduate) are required to register for all three terms (Fall, Winter, Spring/Summer) and arrange to pay their non-refundable Co-op Program Participation fee per four month work term(s) in full upon registration. Final dates for registration and withdrawal from work terms without financial penalty are indicated in the Academic Schedule.

When a Co-op student is employed with the same employer for two or more consecutive work terms, the consecutive work terms will be equivalent to 50% of the Co-op Program Participation Fee.

Co-op Study Term Fee

Four month session (Fall, Winter, Spring/Summer)

The student who has a fall or winter study term, is required to pay Tuition and Ancillary Fees per course as outlined in the Part-time Undergraduate Fees Schedule. For further information, please contact the Accounts Receivable Office, prior to or during registration at 343-8140.

Notes:

1. It may be necessary for students to take FIELD TRIPS or to pay ADDITIONAL FEES as part of their course requirements in programs other than those identified above; if additional fees are required, students will be assessed accordingly. Please see *Schedule of Miscellaneous Fees*.

Disciplines that include Additional Course Fees or Field Trip Fees may include, but are not limited to Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Education, Engineering, Forestry, Geography, Geology, Kinesiology, Music, Outdoor Recreation, Parks & Tourism, and Water Resource Management

Outdoor Recreation - Food and accommodation expenses for mandatory field trips in year 3 will range from \$200.00 to \$500.00 depending on the number of days involved. Expenses charged for optional field trips in years 3 and 4 vary depending on the particular trip.

Non Outdoor Recreation students who are registered in OUTD 1910 and/or 1930 will be subject to a field trip fee of \$35.00 per course.

Non Outdoor Recreation students who are registered in OUTD 1310 will be subject to a field trip fee of \$275.00

Non Outdoor Recreation students who are registered in OUTD 2350 will be subject to a field trip fee of \$200.00

Non HBScF Co-op and Non Co-op Forestry Students who are registered in FORE 3116 will be assessed a field trip fee of \$80.00

2. Convocation Ceremony Fee of \$70.00 is payable upon application to attend and is not transferable or refundable. An additional fee of \$35.00 is charged to rent the required gown. If you request that your degree be mailed, a \$25.00 parchment mailing fee will be charged.

3. The Computer Enhancement (Technology) Fee of \$5.00 per course, up to a maximum of \$25.00 per full-time student, will be applied directly to student access hardware to enhance Lakehead University computing facilities that are of direct benefit to students.

4. LUSU Bus Pass (U-Pass) Fee - All full-time undergraduate students* who have registered in 3.75 or more FCEs for 2016FW by the last day to register in September are automatically assessed this mandatory fee.

5. The LUSU Medical/Dental Insurance cost is \$334.00. The policy is effective September 1, 2016 for the 12 months ending August 31, 2017. All full-time undergraduate students* who have registered in 3.75 or more FCEs for 2016FW by the last day to register in September are automatically assessed this mandatory fee.

The LUSU Medical/Dental Insurance plan is designed to reduce the ever increasing cost of health care and may be combined with any pre-existing plan to maximize coverage.

Should a student have comparable coverage and choose to opt-out they may do so by going to the LUSU Website at www.lusu.ca and clicking on opt-out to proceed. The opt-out period for 2016-17 is from **September 1 to 30, 2016**. ***No exceptions or extensions.***

Bank account information is collected as part of the online opt-out and the reimbursement is deposited by the Insurer to the account by approximately the end of October.

* Co-op students and Graduate students are not covered but may purchase the Plan.

6. LUSU Fee - The LUSU fee is mandatory and will be charged to all courses, including Continuing Education & Distributed Learning, Co-op work terms and self-directed courses.

7. UHIP Coverage - Foreign students and their dependents must enroll in the University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) for health coverage. The premium for a single person is \$612 for 12 months, Canadian funds, including taxes (September 1, 2016 to August 31, 2017)

8. Students will be assessed lab fees, in addition to the fees stated above, please see the Schedule of Miscellaneous Fees for listings by course.

9. Music Students will be assessed \$40.00 for the Lumina Concert Series (See Schedule of Miscellaneous Fees)

10. Teacher Candidates requiring an additional 3rd placement will be assessed a \$750.00 placement fee. The deferred Placement Fee is \$500.00. If a student requires re-registration in EDUC 0450 or 0451 (Math Competency Exam), the fee is \$125.00
