




LOCATION Every year, 10,000 American students and 1,700 international students from more than 70 countries choose Seattle Central.


SCIE (Seattle Central Institute of English)

SCIE offers six levels of instruction. Each level takes 10 weeks to complete. Your English skills will determine your starting point.

Intensive English (Levels 1–3) Make quick progress in this program focusing on speaking, writing, listening, reading, and grammar. Classes are held four hours a day, five days a week.

Advanced English (Levels 4–5) Choose from a variety of stimulating classes geared especially to the needs and interests of international students. Classes are held four hours a day, five days a week.

College Bridge (CB4–CB6) Take the language classes you need along with the college classes you want, and earn transferable college credit at the same time. Most students take classes 15 hours a week. Enter fulltime college classes directly after completing this program—there's no entrance testing required.



College Transfer


This "2 + 2" program allows you to study for two years at Seattle Central, prepare for your major, and graduate with an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree.

After that, you transfer to a four-year college or university for two more years to receive your Bachelor's degree. Our international students have transferred to many selective universities such as the University of Washington, UC Berkeley, Columbia University, UCLA, Dartmouth, and Cornell. Seattle Central has a strong reputation for high quality transfer programs.

Transfer Admission Guarantee

Receive a letter of conditional acceptance from one of our partner four-year institutions at the same time you are admitted to Seattle Central. These two acceptance letters provide a clear four-year pathway to your Bachelor's degree.

Fast Track: High School Completion


Do you need a high school diploma? If you are at least 16 years old, Seattle Central's Fast Track program allows you to satisfy the requirements for a Washington State (U.S.) high school diploma while earning transferable college credits.

Students who enroll in this unique program can choose one of two options:

a) earn only the high school diploma

OR

b) earn both the Associate's degree and the high school diploma at the same time, and save money while you do!

RESOURCES & ACTIVITIES

The **International Student Center** assists students during their time at Seattle Central, from orientation until graduation.

Join one of our 80 clubs, write for the campus newspaper, or become active in student government.

We also offer international students a variety of fun activities, such as movie nights, baseball games, and weekend trips to Canada.

Campus services for international students include:

- Tutoring in ESL and college subjects
- Programs to **practice English outside the classroom** such as Conversation Partners and Coffee Talk
- Help with job searches, resumes, cover letters, interview preparation, and volunteer internships
- Library research tools and databases
- Use of Windows and Macintosh computers at the Computer Center
- The Student Activity Center (Gym), where you can exercise and play sports

HOUSING

Seattle Central has on-campus apartments available to international students. Homestay and neighborhood apartments are also popular <u>housing options</u>.

- On-campus Apartments (Your classes are right across the street!) Provides shared studio housing for new international students aged 17 or older when first enrolled at Seattle Central. Live in the Studios on Broadway during your first year as a student, for the license period that best fits your needs. Our staff take care of all applications and room assignments.
- **Homestay** Gives you an opportunity to experience American life firsthand. To arrange a homestay, you will contact a host family agency directly.
- Apartments Living in a nearby apartment is ideal if you are independent and want to live close to the campus.













COST

As a community college, Seattle Central's tuition is generally much lower than at four-year institutions, making the cost of attendance very attractive!

Tuition for 2013-2014:


- \$8,000 (approximately) per year for an English language program Intensive English/ Advanced English
- \$9,500 (approximately) per year for a college program College Transfer/ College Bridge/ FAST TRACK/ Professional Technical/ Short-Term Certificate
