Summer, Semester, and Academic Year Programs



Experience life as a U.S. university student.

Our short-term programs are immersive in nature. Students live on campus in student housing, they have their meals in the dining halls with other American students and they take classes and study daily with the other students on campus. Participants experience the authentic lifestyle of a typical American student and become familiar with the unique aspects of the U.S. classroom and approach to teaching.



### **Program Duration**

Programs vary in duration depending on location and can last from 4 weeks to 18 months. In general, programs fall under the following categories.

### **Program Options**

Choose the right program and location for you based on your desired length of stay and English proficiency level.

#### ACADEMIC ENGLISH PROGRAMS

As a student on this program, you will have the opportunity to immerse yourself in American student life, the English language, and U.S. culture. The BridgePathways intensive English program will help you to improve your English skills quickly using our customized curriculum and interactive classroom activities.



Proficiency level: beginner to advanced

#### U.S. LANGUAGE & CULTURE PROGRAM

In addition to your English classes, you will also participate in the Bridge U.S. Culture Lab<sup>TM</sup>. This unique series of hands-on tasks are to be completed outside of the classroom in real-life situations. The assignments are designed to allow you to experience U.S. culture first hand, and to reflect upon how those experiences may differ from or challenge some of your own cultural traditions or perspectives. Discussion groups are held once per week, and both international and domestic students are invited to participate.



Proficiency level: beginner to advanced

#### **ENGLISH "PLUS" PROGRAMS**

English Plus is a great option for students who primarily would like to work on their English skills, but who also would like to the opportunity to attend a university course. Students complete an intensive English Program and take a university course as well. The class can be taken for credit, or not for credit, depending on the host university and also on the student's English proficiency level.



Proficiency level: intermediate to advanced

#### CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS – SEMESTER/YEAR ABROAD

If you already have a good understanding of English, you may be able to enroll as a regular student at one of our host universities for a semester or an academic year. This is the ultimate, immersive experience as all of your classes will be taken with American students. Studying abroad for a semester or year in the U.S. is a great resume builder, and will give you an advantage in today's competitive job market.

These programs are taken for credit, and result in a Technical or Professional Certificate from the host university. Some areas of study that may be available are:

- Accounting
- Business Administration
- Counter Terrorism and Security
- Sales
- Supervision



Proficiency level: advanced (can be combined with an intensive English program beforehand)

#### YOUTH HOLIDAY PROGRAMS

Some of our partner universities offer special programs for international students in the summer. These programs usually combine some English classes with an academic component and an experiential component. They also generally include cultural outings and recreational excursions, as well. These programs are a great way to experience many different aspects of U.S. culture in a short period of time.

### On-campus\*

BridgePathways university partners offer a variety of on-campus living arrangements including traditional double-occupancy dormitories, suites, and apartment-style residencies. First-year students are encouraged to live on campus with their classmates. Living on campus is a good way to get involved in university activities, to meet new people, and to make new friends.

### Off-campus

All of our university partners either offer their own off-campus housing or assist international students in securing independent off-campus housing. Living off campus is usually recommended for older, graduate-level students or for students with spouses and children. Living off-campus usually requires taking public transportation to class.

### Host Families

In some cases, BridgePathways is able to secure host family accommodations. Students attending our Denver City Center generally live with host families, as well as younger students who may come to study for the summer. Living with a host family can provide extra support, and encourages students to practice their English at all times.
