

Programs

UNDERGRADUATE (DUAL SWISS/US DEGREE)

Dual Swiss/U.S. Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA)*

Students awarded the BBA will have acquired an understanding of the functions of business organizations and a range of competences appropriate for an international business career providing the basis for managerial entry positions.

Dual Swiss/U.S Bachelor of Arts in International Relations (BA-IR)*

Students earning a degree in International Relations will have acquired the ability to understand and critically analyze current trends in the international system of nation-states, the process of international reasoning, and the impact of socioeconomic issues on the actions of public, private, and civil society.

Information

The entire Undergraduate course requires completion of 120 US credits (40 3-credit classes). In standard cases, it takes 3 years to complete, but can be accomplished in about 2 and a half years, depending on the intensity of studies.

Students in the **DUAL DEGREE Bachelor programs** benefit from our global collaboration with the University of the Potomac, a regionally accredited post-secondary institution located in Washington, D.C. By combining courses online with the U.S. and on ground with **UBIS**, students **graduate with <u>two</u> degrees - one** from the **United States** <u>and</u> **another from Europe - at NO EXTRA Tuition COST!**

Undergraduate Admission Policies

First year undergraduate applicants must be able to provide UBIS with proof of completion of secondary education equivalent to an American high school diploma, 5 passing O levels or A levels in the British system.

As a rule, UBIS only accepts grades of C or higher for transfer credits for undergraduate studies.

Undergraduate applicants should submit the following materials to register for admission:

- A completed and signed Application Form
- A non-refundable application fee of 100 CHF
- Original language and certified copy, in English, of official high school/secondary school transcript along with grade point average
- Original language and certified copy, in English, of student's high school/secondary school diploma if already issued, if pending, a letter from the school stating the student is in good standing and the expected date of graduation
- Official English proficiency test (TOEFL: 78 min Score; IELTS: 6.0 min Score) score (unless native English speaker).
- Personal statement detailing why you wish to attend UBIS for your undergraduate studies.
- Curriculum Vitae detailing educational and professional experience.
- **Photocopy of** the identity page(s) **of personal passport** and Swiss permit if the student has one
- Bank Statement showing at least CHF 9000 or equivalent (if on ground student in need of visa)

UBIS has an articulation agreement with the University of the Potomac, a regionally accredited post-secondary institution located in Washington, D.C. It facilitates the transfer of UBIS credits to University of the Potomac and Potomac credits to UBIS, so that our students can combine courses from both institutions, and graduate with a degree from the United States and another from Europe with no extra cost or supplementary courses.

This collaboration is designed to provide a unique opportunity for UBIS students to pursue their educational goals while gaining international exposure and marketability. UBIS Geneva's articulation agreement with University of the Potomac allows the possibility of studying either 3 full years in Geneva, taking the Potomac courses online, or 2 ½ years in Geneva and ½ year in Washington. In addition, all or part of your course of study can be taken through our virtual campus at UBIS or through Potomac's online educational program.

Both institutions share a mission and vision to provide the best educational opportunities for our students.

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GRADUATE

Dual U.S./Swiss Master in Business Administration (MBA)*

The MBA program is based on the current educational trends in business education. These graduates will be able to accomplish all tasks required from top and mid-level managers, directors, consultants and chief officers. They will be prepared to pursue careers in positions of authority in the private sector, in national public administration, in international organizations or in non-governmental organizations. In these sectors, managerial know-how, business skills, and authority by virtue of acquired knowledge are required.

Bridge MBA (Undergraduate Liberal Arts Majors)

A 12-month program designed to expand career options for recent Liberal Arts and other non-business graduates, looking for career advancement in their current role, or to gain employment. Throughout their studies with us, participants will be put in contact with career professionals and job experts via various networking activities, seminars, and workshops. 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Executive Master in Business Administration (EMBA) Program

UBIS has partnered with several leading business professionals, to develop an executive education program built on an international academic model, with interactive topics on training and development management, strategic thinking, analysis, communications, and technological skills. Our EMBA program is delivered directly online or in a blended (online/on-ground) format where participants have the flexibility to interact with faculty members who is engaged in making the learning experience as stimulating, dynamic and productive. This program is well suited for managers and executives, looking to build their knowledge and certain competences in key business areas at an International level, those looking to develop professionally and invest in their future success, sharing ideas and best practices with their peers while building an international network.



Graduate Admission Policies

Graduate applicants should submit the following materials to register for admission:

- A completed and signed **Application Form**
- A non-refundable application fee of 100 CHF
- Original language and certified copy, in English, of official high school/secondary school diploma and a transcript along with grade point average
- Original language and certified copy, in English, of official undergraduate university transcripts along with grade point average
- Original language and certified copy, in English, of student's undergraduate university diploma(s) showing proof of a 4-year university or 180-ECTS credit undergraduate diploma in the chosen field of study if already issued. If pending, a letter from the school stating the student is in good standing and the expected date of graduation; students who have not done their undergraduate studies in the field of their major will be required to show proof of passing marks for their pre-required undergraduate courses in their transcripts.
- Official English proficiency test (TOEFL: 78 min Score; IELTS: 6.0 min Score) score (unless native English speaker).
- Personal statement detailing why you wish to attend UBIS for your graduate studies.
- Curriculum Vitae detailing educational and professional experience
- A letter of recommendation from a faculty member of undergraduate institution or from a current or recent employer (preferred, but not required)
- Photocopy of the identity page(s) of personal passport and Swiss permit if the student has one.
- Bank Statement showing at least CHF 9000 or equivalent (if on ground student in need of visa)

International Fast-Track MBA

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Course Schedule

The deadline for application is 3 weeks before starting dates; however, students in need of a student entry visa to commence their program must apply 2-4 months in advance of their intended start date in order to have time to procure a visa.

All courses are offered in the traditional classroom setting and online study through our "virtual campus." In addition, courses can also be delivered in a "blended" manner, where a tutor complements the online instruction with several classroom sessions. This allows the student maximum flexibility, and is particularly appropriate for students who work full-time in Geneva.

UBIS in Geneva



Known both as the «smallest of big cities» or the «city of peace» Geneva, among other things, is home to the European headquarters of UNO. The quayside of Lake Geneva, the parks, the old alleys and smart boutiques are an invitation to a leisurely stroll.

Geneva is linked to Europe's capital cities by its international airport, motorways and railway network.

International city

Geneva is the known centre for diplomacy, host to the highest number of international organisations including the headquarters of the United Nations agencies and the Red Cross.

Geneva, known for its banking excellence, is the world's ninth most significant capital centre, being third in Europe after London and Zurich. This city boasts a very high quality of life.

Transport

Geneva, an environmentally conscious city, has pursued a policy of limiting automobile use in towns. Distances are short and all destinations in the city are readily accessible by the excellent public transport system. During rush hour, buses and trams run every few minutes. The buses also connect with destinations in neighboring France. The railway station in the middle of the city connects the traveller to major European cities.

Leisure

Geneva is a center for all kinds of outdoor summer and winter sports. The Lake of Geneva has a large number of harbors and beaches, and the ski resorts of Mt. Blanc are about an hour away. The surrounding mountains provide opportunities for hiking, climbing and rafting.



<u>Cost of Living – Student Life</u>

A student's monthly budget amounts to approximately SFR 2,100.

Here are the fees that should be listed: Accommodation CHF 1250 Food CHF 500 Medical Insurance (required by law) CHF 100 Transport CHF 100 Miscellaneous CHF 150

Students should be aware that several payments fall due simultaneously at the beginning of their studies, for example, first term health insurance payment, first semester tuition fees, first rent payment, which often includes an obligatory security deposit and foreign student medical exam bill.

Language

The national languages of Switzerland are German (North, Central and Eastern Switzerland), French (Western Switzerland), Italian (Southern Switzerland) and Romansh - a derivative of Latin (South-Eastern Switzerland). It is possible to study in all three official languages in many schools & universities in Switzerland. However, English is not one of Switzerland's national languages. As mentioned earlier, all courses at UBIS are delivered in English.

Accommodation

Geneva has a long tradition and therefore rooms for students are available all over the town. The typical monthly rent ranges from about 800 CHF for a small room with minimum amenities up to 1500 CHF and more for a studio.

We will provide assistance; however, we also encourage you to be proactive in looking for residences.

Visa procedure for Switzerland

When the student has received confirmation of acceptance by a Swiss university or private school, he/she must contact the Swiss embassy in his/her country for information on entry formalities for Switzerland. He/she will have to show proof that he/she has adequate financial means to support himself/herself during your studies.

The student will have to apply to the police department dealing with aliens after arrival in Switzerland to obtain a residence permit. The student will have to present the following documents:

- a valid passport, if necessary with a visa
- o confirmation that the student has been accepted by a Swiss university
- a guarantee of sufficient financial means for support during your studies (e.g. bank statement)
- statement concerning the address in Switzerland
- The residence permit will only be issued if the financial means are guaranteed.

In addition, he/she will have to renew the residence permit annually.




