



SARATOV





- **Saratov** is located 858 km south-east of Moscow.
- **Saratov** is a major cultural, economic and educational city in the European part of Russia on the banks of the Volga River.
- The city stretches along the river for 34 km.
- **Saratov** was founded as a fortress to protect the southern borders of the Russian state in 1590.
- **Saratov** is an important industrial center in the Volga region. Saratov Aviation Plant is one of the main industrial enterprises of the city. Mechanical engineering, as well as oil and chemical industry are developed in Saratov.

Population of the city — 843 460 people (the 16th largest city out of 1114 cities of Russia)

The city's area - 394 km²

The average temperature in February -8°C, inJuly +22,7°C.

The type of climate is moderately continental.

TRANSPORT

Flight from Saratov to Moscow (Vnukovo, Domodedovo or Sheremetievo airports) takes **2,5 hours**. Regular daily flights from Moscow to Saratov are operated by «Aeroflot», «Saratov Airlines», «Hahn Air».



The distance from Moscow by train is 858 km. The train overcomes this distance in 15-16 hours. The ticket price is about 30 USD.





In Saratov there is an extensive public transport network: 114 bus, tram and trolleybus lines. The main passenger flow through the city is transported by buses and mini-buses.

The cost of one bus trip is 0,20 USD, of one mini-bus trip is 0,22 USD.


The average taxi trip in the city is 3-4,5 USD.

- Saratov State Medical University (SSMU) was founded in 1909 and is one of the oldest medical educational institutions in Russia. In June 2016 it celebrated its 107th anniversary.
- Currently, the structure of SSMU consists of **9 departments** (including Medical, Dental, Pharmaceutical) and **75 sub-departments**.
- International activity of SSMU started in 1991.
- Now there are about 800 foreign students at the university from 52 countries.
- The department for foreign students that offer programs partially taught in **English** was opened in 2003.

Saratov State Medical University named after V. I. Razumovsky



- The University has **more than 4000 students**, interns, residents and PhD students. Since its opening the university held **120 graduation ceremonies** with about **45 000 graduates**. Each year Saratov State Medical University prepares about 600 graduated high-qualified doctors.
- During the course of study students undergo clinical practice in the hospitals of the city.




- Upon completion of studies at the University graduates receive a diploma of Russian national standard indicating degree / qualification and specialty.
- Graduate may also get an additional document "European Diploma Supplement", which allows to get the equivalence of diploma in any of 47 European and other countries of European Higher Education Area.

Offered specialties:

- General Medicine (6 years): English medium, Russian medium,
- **Dentistry** (5 years): Russian medium,
- Pharmacy (5 years): Russian medium,
- Clinical psychology (5,5 years): Russian medium,

- Pediatrics (6 years): Russian medium.

- Saratov State Agrarian University (SSAU) was founded in **1913** and is **one of the leading educational institutions preparing specialists for agricultural sector** of the region. In June 2016 it celebrated its **103**rd **anniversary**.
- Currently, the structure of SSAU consists of 6 departments.
- There are 43 Specialist's Degree programs, 14 Bachelor's Degree programs and 6 Master's Degree programs. **More than 22 000 students** are being trained at the University on the full-time and correspondence courses.
- More than 100 000 qualified specialists have been prepared since the foundation of the University.



- Educational process and scientific work are currently managed by **1317 highly qualified teachers**, including 992 professors with PhD degrees.
- International activity of SSAU started in 2009. Today the University is part of a small number of Russian agrarian universities that admit foreign students from abroad.
- The University is rated in the top 100 Russian universities and ranked #2 among agrarian universities.
- Saratov State Agrarian University offers English medium programs in Veterinary and Agronomy.
- Graduate may also get an additional document "European Diploma Supplement", which allows to get the equivalence of diploma in any of 47 European and other countries of European Higher Education Area.

Admission approval for studies at Russian university (pre-registration) takes **no more than 5 days**. Requirements to the educational documents of foreign nationals for admission to Russian universities **are similar to the requirements in their home country**.
