

Barrie Campus

The key to this waterfront city's beauty lies not only in its beaches along Kempenfelt Bay, but in its central location to recreational opportunities throughout Simcoe County. World-class biking and ski trails, downhill adventures, and boating opportunities are waiting for you within the city limits or only a short distance away.

Although it boasts big-city amenities, Barrie still exudes the warmth of a small town. A robust nightlife in the downtown core, complemented by trendy restaurants and a strong arts and culture presence, makes it a popular hotspot for residents and visitors. And, if Toronto calls to you, it's only a short GO Train trip or drive away.

Orillia Campus

Known as the "Sunshine City," Orillia borders three lakes, with several nearby provincial parks and the historic Trent-Severn Waterway to offer an abundance of beaches, camping opportunities and trails. 

He needed help with time management, studying skills and even finding his way around campus. Luckily, he got connected to the First Year Experience office, one of many student services offered at Georgian.


