Study Plan

First Year

Thefirstyearisdesignedtobuildafoundationfor a successful BBA journey through the development of essential knowledge, skills, and personal insights. Students are tested for levels of development, learn about expectations and standards, and become familiar with the values of MIU including global vision, innovation, and real-world application. The curriculum covers key business subjects and introduces essential context and appreciation for the wider world in which business operates.

Second Year

The second year of the BBA builds on the foundational blocks in year 1, and introduces practical courses which test and develop the student's skills and approach to business. Fundamentals subjects become more complex and there is a strong element offinance and numeracy. Italso includes the introduction of technology courses.

Third Year

Students will continue with subjects such as strategy, finance and economics, and supply chain management which build on the foundational coursesofthefirsttwoyears.Thesesubjectsbenefit fromtheknowledgeandexperiencesinthefirsthalf of the BBA.

The third year of the BBA introduces a strong element of digitalization which shows the University commitment to cross-disciplinary learning and insight into innovation.

Fourth Year

Core courses are available in semesters one and two, followed by a final semester which includes the Business Administration Capstone Project.

The final year allows deep-diving into the fundamental courses related to the different areas of management (strategy, economy, HR) and broadening knowledge on new subjects and skills (fiscality, investment, business intelligence, analytics...)

During the Capstone Project, students will apply knowledge into practice by completing a research project utilizing the skills and knowledge that they gained through their BBA's program coursework.

Admission Process

Students must follow the following process to be admitted to our Bachelor in Business Administration.



At <u>miuniversity.edu/contact</u> or write an email to admissions@miuniversity.edu.



To formalize your admission, complete the online Application (crm.miuniversity.edu/applicationform) and send the required documentation to admissions@miuniversity.edu:

- \rightarrow High School degree transcript translated in English
- \rightarrow Copy of valid government issued ID or Passport
- \rightarrow Updated Resume
- \rightarrow Certificate of English Intermediate Level (*)
- → Scholarship Application (if requested)

You will also be asked to pay a non-refundable Application fee (\$50 US residents, \$150 International students) and a US Degree Recognition fee - Foreign Credential Evaluation FCE (\$160).

(*) TOEFL/IELTS/PTE or alternative qualification, such as a university degree entirely conducted in English. If you do not have a certificate, MIU provides a free online language assessment test.



Speak with a personal advisor to verify if you meet the course requirements and help you prepare your admissions process.



After submitting your application, we need to determine the equivalency of your foreign High School degree in the US. Please note that you will only be able to enroll in the BBA if your FCE is approved.



Admissions committee decision

After evaluating your entire application, we will get back to you with a decision. If you are accepted, you will receive your Acceptance Letter and Enrollment Agreement.

Recognition of prior learning (credit transfer)

MIU has a Commission Credit Transfer Agreement that is responsible for carrying out the relevant recognition for prior learning. Speak with your personal advisor and will evaluate your particular case.

F1 Student Visa

If you have decided to study your program On Campus in Miami and you are an international student, you need to apply for an F1 Student Visa, which can be processed with the assistance of MIU.



How to get your student visa?

- 1. Once we accept your enrollment, you will be registered for the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) and must pay the SEVIS I-901 fee (\$350).
- In parallel, your personal advisor at MIU will send you a link to complete and pay the Form I-20 (\$250). Once we receive the payment receipt, we will send you the Form I-20.
- **3.** After you receive the Form I-20 and register in SEVIS, you may apply at the U.S Embassy or Consulate for a F1 visa.
- **4.** You must present the Form I-20, MIU's Acceptance Letter and Enrollment Agreement when you attend your visa interview.
- **5.** The administrative office of your Embassy will get back to you with the F1 visa resolution.
- ↔ We recommend international students to begin the admission process with enough time before classes start to have time to complete the visa process.

Fees & Scholarships

Course fees
