MBA International Business	<u>MBA 60 ECTS** (2 semesters):</u> 210 ECTS from undergraduate studies (Bachelor or Diploma), at least 2 years of practical work experience in management relevant field <u>MBA 90 ECTS** (3 semesters):</u> 180 ECTS from undergraduate studies (Bachelor) + at least 2 years of practical work experience in management relevant field

*English language courses starting at IELTS level 3.0 available at IUBH to achieve the required level.

** ECTS (European Credit Transfer System): Official standard system for comparing the study attainment and performance of students of higher education across the European Union and other collaborating European countries based on the estimated student workload. In general 60 ECTS can be achieved in one year of study.
