EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

Rheinisches Studienkolleg is a private institute located in the capital of Germany - Berlin - and the former capital - Bonn.

The foundation-courses (M, T and W) comprise 10 months of lessons and prepare international students for the diverse subjects of the external examination „Feststellungsprüfung“.

To assure a smooth transition to the different examinations and university applications we offer two intakes - one in summersemester (January) and one in wintersemester (July).

Admission is open all year long for both branches enabling students to apply and enrol conveniently.



M-COURSE

The M-course is the foundation of university studies at public universities in the field of medicine, biology and pharmacy.

The subjects of M-course strictly follow the external examinations by the relevant authorities (public universities and governmental bodies).

As these authorities differ from state to state the subjects and examinations differ alike.

Accordingly the subjects are

- Biology (Berlin/Bonn)
- Chemistry (Berlin/Bonn)
- German (Berlin/Bonn)
- Mathematics (Berlin)
- Physics (Berlin/Bonn)

T-COURSE

The T-course will prepare students who specifically aim at studying mathematics, natural-scientific or technical degrees.

Hence the T-course contains relevant subjects to successfully pass the external examinations of the states of Berlin and Northrhine-Westphalia.

Relevant subjects to the T-course

- Chemistry (Berlin/Bonn)
- Computer-science (Berlin)
- German (Berlin/Bonn)
- Mathematics (Berlin/Bonn)
- Physics (Berlin/Bonn)

Enrolling in business related study fields or social studies requires participation in the W-course.

The selection of examination subjects is similar both in Berlin and Northrhine-Westphalia, yet at both campuses the lessons vary.

Subjects of W-course are

- Economics (Berlin/Bonn)
- English (Berlin/Bonn)
- German (Berlin/Bonn)
- Mathematics (Berlin/Bonn)

APPLICATION

International students apply through the relevant website (Bonn or Berlin) and hand in a set of files as hard copies.

The application shall contain:

- CV
- Copy of passport
- High school diploma and transcript as attested copy
- Certificate of German language level B2 or attested copy
- Signed studienkolleg-contract

All applications are screened as quickly as possible to allow a fast processing of admission.
